

Dennie to continue as Plipdeco president until January

DR CURTIS DENNIE will continue to serve as president of the Point Lisas Industrial Port Development Corporation Ltd (Plipdeco) until January 31, 2026.

In a 'notice of material change' filed with the Trinidad and Tobago Stock Exchange under Section 64(1)(b) of the Securities Act 2012, the Plipdeco board stated: 'Effective 1st November 2025, Dr Curtis Dennie shall continue to serve as president of the Corporation for a further period of three months, concluding on January 31, 2026.'

This extension follows Dennie's initial appointment as president on August 1 for a threemonth term ending October 31.

Plipdeco has experienced significant leadership turnover over the past year. In July 2024, then-president Ernest Ashley Taylor was placed on administrative leave and subsequently retired in December 2024. Board members also resigned, including Haydn Jones in September 2024 and Ayanna Miguel in February 2025.

Dr Averne Pantin, previously vice president of technical services, was appointed acting president in January 2025 but resigned the following month.

In July 2025, the entire board stepped down, prompting the appointment of a new board, with Ramnarine Persad named chairman.

Dennie, who previously served as vice president of port operations, was appointed acting president during this transitional period.
