Plipdeco gets new president

It said, "Pursuant to Section 64(1)(b) of the Securities Act 2012, the board of directors of Point Lisas Industrial Port Development Corporation Ltd hereby notifies of the following material change: "Effective August 1, 2025, Dr Curtis Dennie, who previously held the position of vice president—port operations, has been appointed to the position of president of the corporation, for a period of three months, concluding on 31, October, 2025. The board of directors extends its congratulations to Dr Dennie on this appointment and expresses its full confidence in his leadership during this interim period."

The entire board of Plipdeco resigned, effective July 18, following the change of government at the end of April.
